Re: NP/DIS/1220/1202

Discharge of Condition 3 on NP/HPK/0420/0328, Listed Building Consent for the temporary removal of the existing gateposts to facilitate access and to protect the assets during the work at Edale Road, Edale.

I refer to the details submitted 18 December 2020, regarding condition 3, and further clarifications received by email 4 January 2021.

Condition 3 required the submission of a detailed construction and recording methodology (including: methodology for carrying out photographic and drawn recording; dismantling, storage and reinstatement; and timescales) for written approval before any works were carried out.

The plans, drawings and methodology statement which were submitted have been considered by the Authority's Conservation Officer, as have the further clarifications provided, and they are satisfied that the details submitted are acceptable.

Condition 3 can therefore be considered partly discharged, and will be considered fully discharged at such time as the works have been completed in accordance with the details provided. A photograph of the reinstated gate posts would be appreciated at that time.

The works must now proceed in accordance with the approved plans and the remaining conditions attached to NP/HPK/0420/0328.
